TRAFFIC AND SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, January 9th, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM by Chairman Paul DeWitt. Members in attendance: Paul DeWitt, Bill Barker, Janice Lembo and Elliott Wiser. Members absent: Brian Manty and Bruce Epstein. Also attending were the Site Supervisor, Bob Davis with Securitas Security, along with our Administrative Assistant, Marci Colton.

Amy Mallory affirmed the meeting was noticed in accordance with Florida State Statutes.

Bob Davis introduced himself as the new Site Supervisor for Securitas and explained his background and his goals for the security team.

Derik Palmer, President of Accurate Electronics joined us to explain his proposals to the committee for new cameras at the west gate, controllers, as well as RFID readers at both the east and west gates. The committee asked questions about the products, service, contract and timeline for changing out the new system.

Elliot Wiser brought up concerns about the new security officers assigned to the Bayou Club. Amy Mallory explained that James Davis, Branch Manager for Securitas Security, sent several new security officers who did not have any experience and only recently obtained their security license. Amy and Paul explained they were planning to have a meeting with James Davis to discuss our concerns and disappointment.
